About Learn More Indiana:

Learn More Indiana is a strategic statewide communication effort to support the state's goal of raising the educational attainment of Hoosiers.

This effort is made possible through a partnership of the Indiana Commission for Higher Education, the Indiana Department of Education, the Indiana Department of Workforce Development, and the State Student Assistance Commission. Additional support is received through USA Funds, Inc. and Lumina Foundation for Education.

As the state's college and career connection, Learn More Indiana works to reach parents, students, school counselors and communities with the information needed to support learning pre-K through college completion. Services and outreach efforts include:

- **Publications** – up-to-date and easy-to-read publications, checklists and other helpful print materials to support learning from the early years, through K-12 education, college and beyond.
- **Website** – www.learnmoreindiana.org - a one-stop online information source for Hoosiers on education and careers - including early learning, K-12, higher education, apprenticeships and other training. Learn More College Connection connects students to everything they need to know about getting to and succeeding in college.
- **Helpline** – 1-800-992-2076 – a toll-free call-center to provide college and career information 24/7/365, including information on paying for college and applying for financial aid.
- **Student Surveys** – data to inform schools, communities and policy-makers about student postsecondary aspirations, perceived barriers and access needs. These surveys also provide a way to link students directly with Indiana's colleges and universities and provide valuable information to improve school counseling and communication efforts.
- **Campaigns** – targeted marketing and media tactics (like KnowHow2Go) that expose Indiana audiences to important messages combined with local outreach tactics that provide more personalized contact to move Hoosiers from awareness to action. Priority issues include high school dropout prevention, Core 40 completion, 21st Century Scholars enrollment, college preparation, college access and success.
- **Community Alliances** – partnership building with organizations, agencies, schools and others “on-the-ground” in communities across the state to reach parents, students and families with proactive information on learning more.

With the overarching goal of assisting the state in raising the educational attainment of Hoosiers, Learn More Indiana supports improving student success at every level with priority efforts to:

- Increase number of Hoosiers who complete a postsecondary program (apprenticeships, military training, workforce certification, 2- and 4- year degrees, and beyond)
- Increase parent support for student learning and achievement
- Increase number of K-12 students who are setting sights on college and careers in middle school
- Increase the number of K-12 students who have a plan for education after high school
- Increase number of students who finish high school
- Increase number of students graduating high school prepared for success in college and work
- Increase the number of students who receive career and college planning assistance
- Increase number of students who have access to a college education
- Increase the number of Hoosier adults who further or continue their education
