Jane Hoepfner to Speak at College and Career Planning Workshop for Monroe County Students and Families

Event designed to increase college readiness including knowledge on how to pay

BLOOMINGTON – On June 6, Indiana’s College Success Coalition will host a college & career exploration workshop designed to increase college-knowledge among Monroe County middle and high school students. The event will be held at Ivy Tech Bloomington in Lamkin Hall between 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. The workshop will begin with a motivational speech by Jane Hoepfner, wife of late IU football coach Terry Hoepfner.
