Funds Available for Local College Access and Success Efforts

Community groups and youth-serving organizations could receive up to \$60,000

Indiana nonprofit organizations looking to enhance their community's college access and success efforts can apply for grants to help with network building, public awareness, and policy and advocacy.

Learn More Indiana—a state-led communications and community outreach partnership working to help Hoosiers succeed in school, complete college and connect to careers—will provide grants through a competitive process. The request for proposal (RFP) invites current and prospective members of Indiana's College Success Coalition to apply for grant awards ranging from \$30,000 to \$60,000 by July 30, 2010. Eligible entities include college access programs, community-based and youth programs that provide direct services, and schools.
